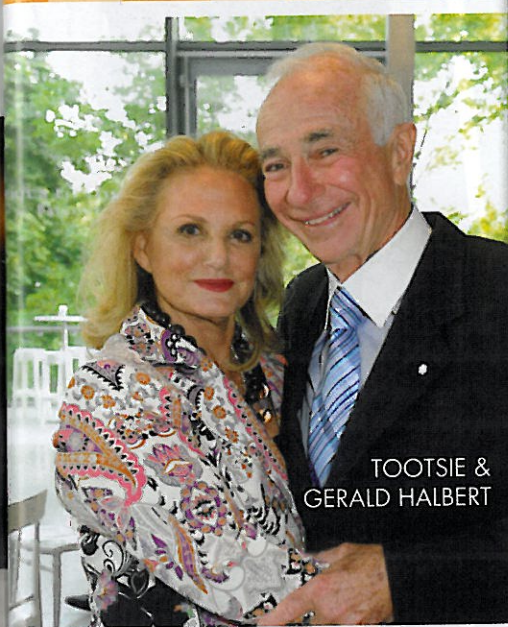


GERALD & TOOTSIE HALBERT TRIBUTE EVENT

At the stunning Koerner Hall at the Royal Conservatory of Music in Toronto, Gerald and Tootsie Halbert were celebrated for their years of volunteer service, support, and dedication to the University Hospital Network. Their greatest philanthropic impact has been on the Krembil Neuroscience Centre at Toronto Western hospital; Gerald has helped raise \$135 million to benefit patient care and research at the hospital, and Tootsie has given her time to a host of causes in the community as well. In honor of the couple's contributions, the Krembil family has provided a gift of \$2 million, which, matched by other generous donors, has helped create the \$4 million Gerald and Tootsie Halbert Chair in Neural Repair and Regeneration. 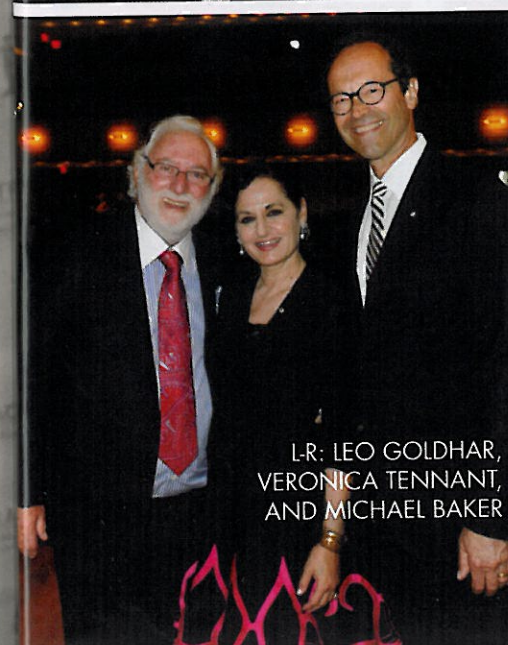

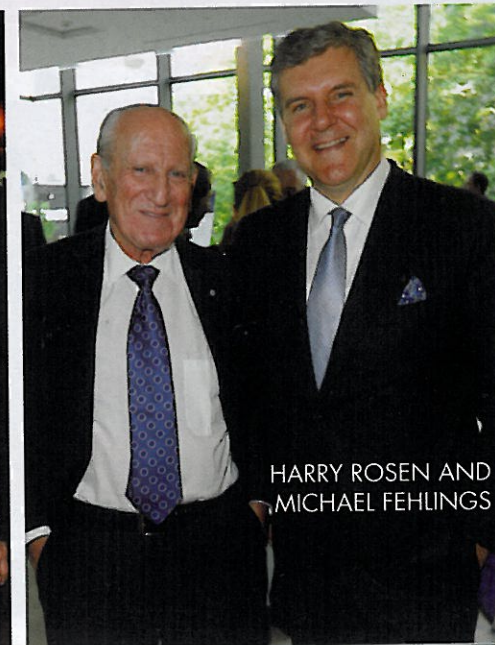
